

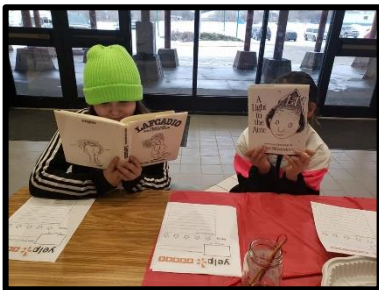

Due to the cold weather which brought low attendance, we will have our January awards combined with the February assembly on February 5, 2020 at 9 am.

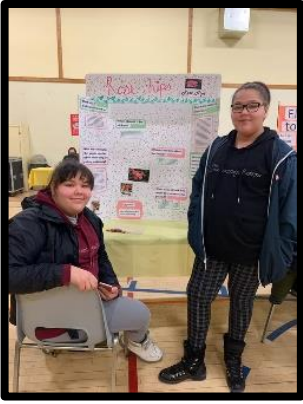
### STUDENT ALLOWANCE

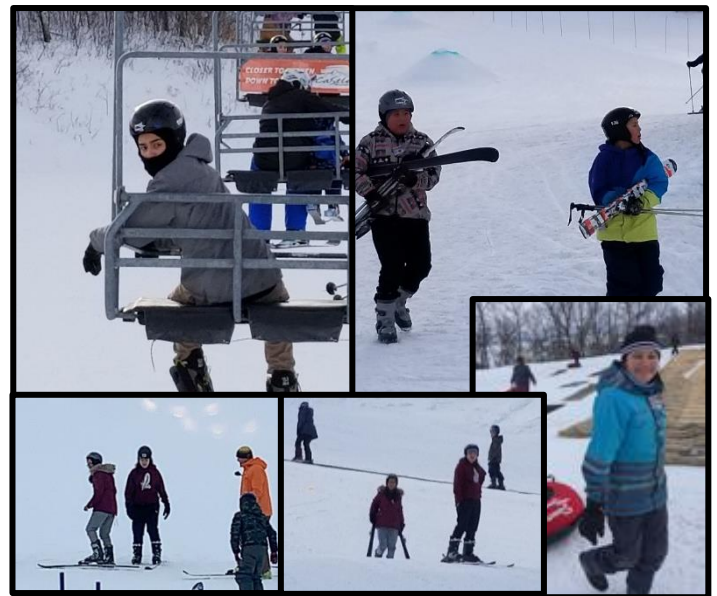
