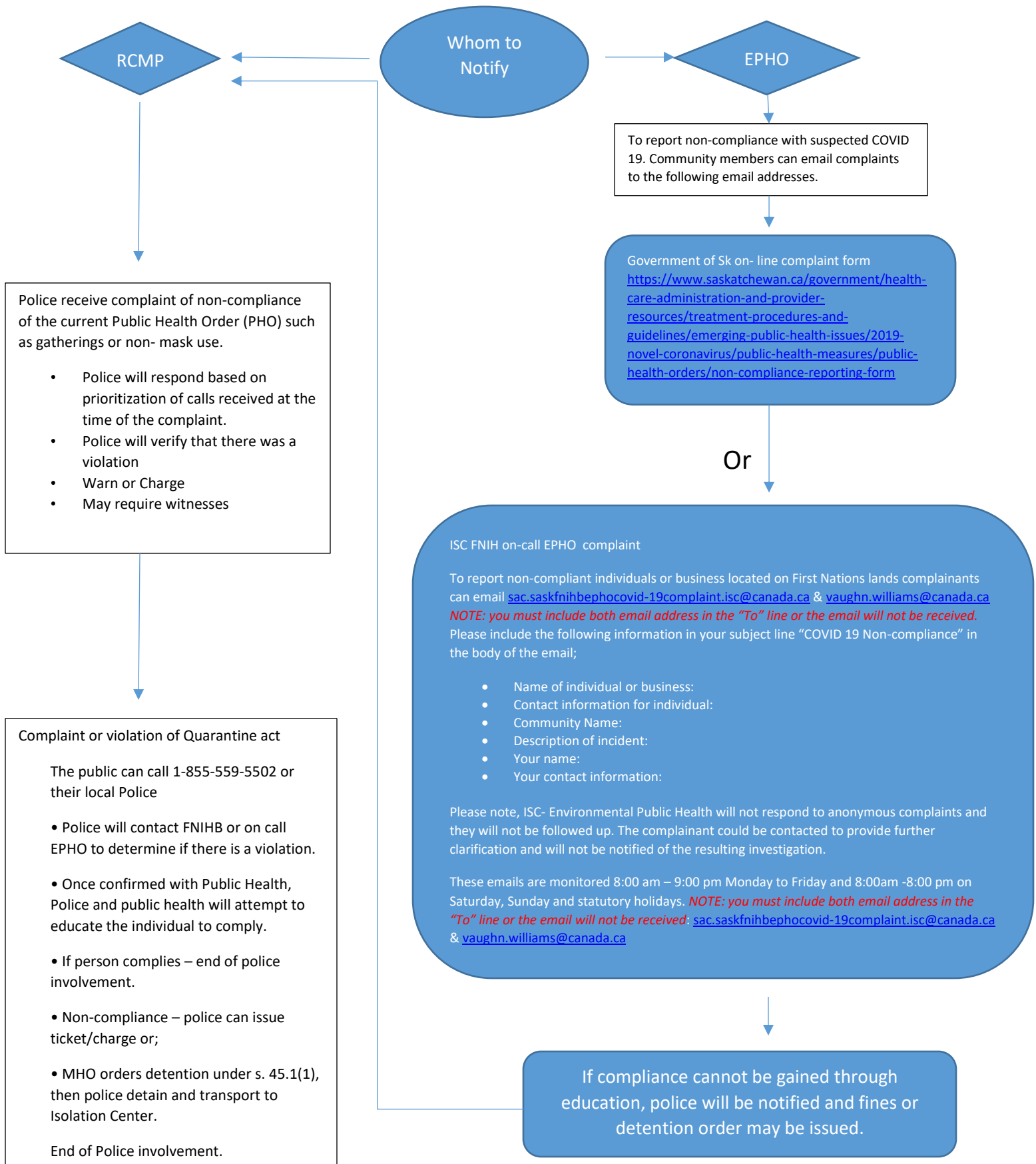


RCMP and ISC-FNIH Response Process for Non Compliance of current COVID Public Health Orders



Police receive complaint of non-compliance of the current Public Health Order (PHO) such as gatherings or non- mask use.

- Police will respond based on prioritization of calls received at the time of the complaint.
- Police will verify that there was a violation
- Warn or Charge
- May require witnesses

Complaint or violation of Quarantine act

The public can call 1-855-559-5502 or their local Police

- Police will contact FNIHB or on call EPHO to determine if there is a violation.
- Once confirmed with Public Health, Police and public health will attempt to educate the individual to comply.
- If person complies – end of police involvement.
- Non-compliance – police can issue ticket/charge or;
- MHO orders detention under s. 45.1(1), then police detain and transport to Isolation Center.

End of Police involvement.

If compliance cannot be gained through education, police will be notified and fines or detention order may be issued.
